

#### Words from Father Constantine

#### Holy Fathers of the Seventh Ecumenical Council

Today the Church remembers the 350 holy Fathers of the Seventh Ecumenical Council under the holy Patriarch Tarasius (February 25). The Synod of 787, the second to meet at Nicea, refuted the Iconoclast heresy during the reign of Empress Irene and her son Constantine VI. The Council decreed that the veneration of icons was not idolatry (Exodus 20:4-5), because the honor shown to them is not directed to the wood or paint, but passes to the prototype (the person depicted). It also upheld the possibility of depicting Christ, Who became man and took flesh at His Incarnation. The Father, on the other hand, cannot be represented in His eternal nature, because "no man has seen God at any time" (John 1:18).

The Seventh Ecumenical accomplished two things, it continued to uphold the Christology which had been taught at previous councils and defend the importance of iconography in the Church. Jesus Christ was both a real person that existed in human history as well as the divine Son of God, the eternal Word made flesh. Christ brought together in a perfect manner humanity and divinity. And it is because of this that he can be depicted in iconographic form. The icon is an image in fact all icons are an icon of Christ, as it shows a Saint. What it is showing is the image of God shown through that person. Thus the use of icons is an important part of the faith confirming what the Church teaches about Christ.

Please put your lunches into refrigerator in the Church Hall (Thank You!)


